Storing inoperative motor vehicles (cars, trucks, RVs boats, motorcycles etc.) or vehicle parts is prohibited in most cases throughout the Township as per the Clean Yards By-law.

Spring is a great time to ensure that you are complying with this and other regulations of the Clean Yards by-law.

How to Dispose of Derelict Vehicles

- Cash for Scrap - A number of area merchants will pick-up the vehicle & pay cash for the scrap metal. Do some research to ensure that you are contacting a licensed wrecking yard!
- Donation – Many organizations offer a free tow, tax receipt and the great feeling you've helped the environment and people in a number of registered Canadian Charities by donating your unused vehicle. Some examples of these programs include Cars for Kidneys and Car Heaven. Contact these organizations directly for more information.

Clean Yards Tips

- ❖ Ensure your property is clean and free from refuse and/or debris,
- ❖ Maintain vegetation including hedges and shrubs
- ❖ Swimming pools, & man-made ponds must be in good repair and working condition and may require fencing
