



### **Paper Box Recyclables**

**Ensure that no loose material is on top that will blow out and cause litter**

- ✓ Newspaper & flyers (glossy or plain)
- ✓ Fine paper (i.e. writing, computer, mail)
- ✓ Boxboard such as cereal, cracker & cookie boxes, detergent/laundry cartons, shoe & tissue boxes, over the counter drug boxes (i.e. toothpaste, toiletries, cough syrups, medicine and cosmetics), paper egg cartons, toilet & paper towel rolls and pizza boxes.
- ✓ Magazines, catalogues & telephone directories
- ✓ Corrugate cardboard – flatten all boxes before placing in the *Paper Box*. Large boxes can be flattened and placed beside or under your *Paper Box*.

### **Contaminants that should not be placed in *Paper Box***

- X** No plastic bags
- X** No plastic tubs or bottles
- X** No Styrofoam
- X** No waxed or coated boxes
- X** No glass
- X** No cans or metal

### **Blue Box Recyclables**

**Ensure all items are empty and rinsed clean**

- ✓ Glass food and beverage bottles & jars
- ✓ Metal food & beverage cans
- ✓ **Clean empty paint cans – lids must be off** & aerosol cans
- ✓ Plastic bottles – only items marked on the bottom with a recycling symbol ♻️ containing the numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 (i.e. soft drink, juice & water, LCBO, household detergents, home cleaning & laundry products, windshield washer, vinegar, shampoo & lotion bottles)
- ✓ Aluminum pie plates & foil, rigid foil containers & trays
- ✓ Margarine and yogurt tubs

### **Contaminants that should not be placed in *Blue Box***

- X** No motor oil bottles or herbicide/pesticide bottles
- X** No Light Bulbs
- X** No window glass, dishes, or mirrors
- X** No Styrofoam
- X** No pots & pans
- X** No paper
