
The CAO/Clerk welcomed those present and introduced the subject of the meeting which was to discuss and consider the rezoning of approximately 18 hectares of land at 208 Dobbie Rd. The CAO noted that the purpose of the amendment is to change the zoning of the property from Agricultural (A) to Agricultural Special Exception (A-7), in order to prohibit future residential uses. It was noted that the effect of the amendment would be to fulfil a consent condition which applies to the retained lands resulting from the severance of a dwelling deemed to be surplus to a farming operation.

The CAO read the notice which explains the Planning Act process for the approval and appeal of the decision and outlined the effect of the amendment.

The CAO asked if anyone wished to make a comment in support for or in opposition to the rezoning for approximately 18 hectares of land at 208 Dobbie Rd. There were no comments in favour of or against the proposal.

The CAO noted that the zoning by-law amendment will be considered by Council at their regular meeting on May 27, 2019 and once the decision is made by Council and notification is provided, there will be a 21-day appeal period.
