RE: Tax Payments during the COVID-19 Pandemic

Municipal Council passed a resolution at the March 23rd regular meeting of Council that will extend the 2020 interim tax bill due date from March 31st to **May 31st, 2020**. This measure was instituted to provide short term relief for residents and businesses that have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

We encourage residents and businesses that are able to make payments sooner than the extended deadline to do so using one of the following options.

- **Online Banking.** Set up “Edwardsburgh/Cardinal” as a payee with your online banking provider, using your property roll number as your account number.
- **Telephone Banking.** Phone the 1-800 number on the back of your interac card to make payment arrangements through your bank.
- **Mailed Cheque.** Please mail your cheque to PO Box 129, Spencerville ON K0E 1X0.

We also offer a **monthly payment plan** to spread your payments out over the year instead of one lump sum. Visit our website for details and an authorization form
