BY-LAW NO. 2020- 03

**“A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE SEWER RATES FOR USERS OF THE SANITARY
SEWER SYSTEM ON COUNTY ROAD 2 AND IN THE EDWARDSBURGH
CARDINAL INDUSTRIAL PARK”**

WHEREAS the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, Subsection 290, as amended, provides that the council of a local municipality shall in each year prepare and adopt a budget, including estimates of all sums required during the year for the purposes of any board, commission or other body;

AND WHEREAS Section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 as amended provides for a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Edwardsburgh/Cardinal deems it expedient to establish sewer rates for the Sanitary Sewer System on County Road 2 and in the Edwardsburgh/Cardinal Industrial Park;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Edwardsburgh/Cardinal enacts as follows:

1. Rates and charges shall be determined in accordance with Schedule “A” attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
2. The rates and charges shall be retroactive to January 1st, 2020 upon passing of this by-law.
3. Charges shall be billed monthly. Amounts unpaid after 30 days shall be charged interest at the rate of 1.25% per month. At the discretion of the Treasurer of the municipality, outstanding accounts may be added to the collector’s roll and collected in a like manner as taxes, according to Section 398(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, SO 2001.
4. That By-law 2019-12 is hereby repealed.
5. This by-law shall be known as the “Industrial Park Sewer Rate By-law”



Schedule "A"
By-law 2020- 03

SEWER RATES

1. Each user shall be billed a minimum flat rate of \$55.00 per month.
2. Each user shall be billed \$1.4540 per cubic meter of water consumed for operation and maintenance of the collection and treatment system.
3. Each user shall be billed \$0.077 per cubic meter of water consumed for capital replacement of the collection and treatment systems and funds so collected shall be placed in the Industrial Park Sewers Reserve Fund.
