

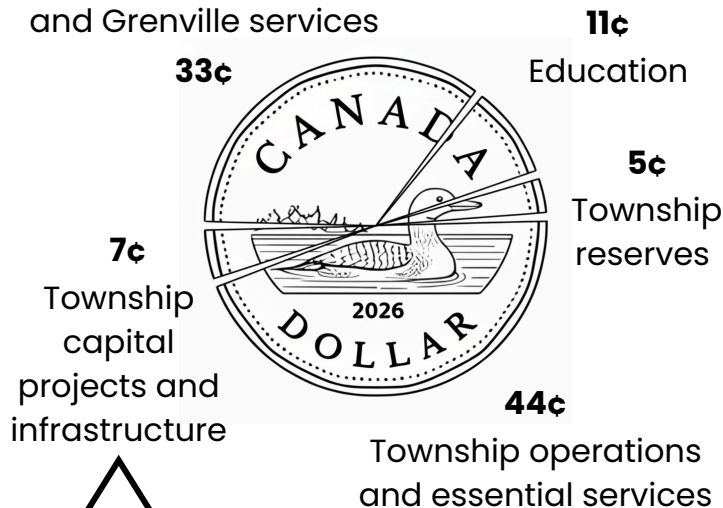
YOUR 2026 FINAL TAX NOTICE

Your August Final Tax Bill reflects Council's approved 2026 budget and completes your annual property tax payment for the year. The information below explains where your property taxes go and the payment options available.

WHERE DO MY PROPERTY TAXES GO?

Your property tax dollar is shared between municipal, county, and education services. The Township collects all property taxes and distributes the County and Education portions on their behalf.

HOW TO PAY YOUR PROPERTY TAXES

Your 2026 Final Tax Bill payment is due by August 31, 2026. Interest accrues after the due date at 1.25% per month.
