BY-LAW NO. 2026-26

**“BEING A BY-LAW TO LEVY THE FINAL ASSESSMENT OF COST FOR THE
MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FERGUSON MUNICIPAL DRAIN”**

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal authorized drainage works on the Ferguson Municipal Drain in accordance with Section 74 of the Drainage Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 61(1) of the Drainage Act, RSO 1990, Chapter D17 requires that a Council that is required to raise the whole or part of the cost of a drainage works shall impose upon the lands assessed for the drainage works the assessment with which it is chargeable;

AND WHEREAS Section 61(2), (3), (4) and (5) of the Drainage Act, RSO 1990, Chapter D17 authorizes the manner and means by which the charges may be levied and collected;

AND WHEREAS Section 85 of the Drainage Act, RSO 1990, Chapter D17 provides that grants may be made in respect of assessments made under this Act upon lands used for agricultural purposes;

AND WHEREAS application was made for a grant and grants are subject to available budget in the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal enacts as follows:

1. That the assessments of cost less applicable grants are hereby imposed on the respective properties pursuant to Schedule “A” attached hereto and forming part of this by-law;
2. That the Treasurer is authorized to apply for a grant in the amount shown on Schedule “A” attached;
3. That all assessments of \$300.00 or less are payable within thirty (30) days of the invoice date;
4. That all assessments of more than \$300.00 and less than \$5,000.00 are payable in the first year which the assessment is imposed;
5. That where the assessment against any parcel of land is \$50.00 or less, the assessment shall be paid out of general funds of the municipality;
6. That all outstanding balances in default shall be added to the Tax Collector’s Roll and recovered as taxes pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act 2001 as amended;
7. That this by-law shall come into force on the passing thereof and may be cited as the “Ferguson Municipal Drain Assessment By-law”.

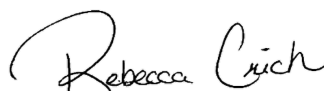
