Skyview 2 Battery Energy Storage Project
Class Environmental Assessment for Transmission Facilities

Skyview BESS Inc. (the "Proponent") has completed a <u>Class Environmental</u> Assessment for Transmission Facilities¹ ("Class EA for TF") for the proposed construction of the Skyview 2 Battery Energy Storage Project (the "Project" or "Skyview 2 BESS"). Skyview BESS Inc. is indirectly owned by subsidiaries of the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nation and Power Sustainable Energy Infrastructure (PSEIP"), a private investment fund. Potentia Renewables Inc. ("Potentia") a subsidiary of Power Corporation of Canada, provides asset management services to PSEIP and Skyview. The Project is located in the Township of Edwardsburgh Cardinal, near the intersection of County Road 22 and Dobbie Road.

The Project will provide electricity storage capacity of up to approximately 411 megawatts ("MW") from the provincial

power grid. The BESS facility will provide energy storage that will be charged from the provincial electricity grid and will discharge back to the grid during times of system demand, when dispatched by the Independent Electricity Service Operator (IESO). The BESS will occupy approximately 19 hectares (ha) (47 acres) of land and include the battery enclosures, a substation, security fence, aboveground transmission line, transmission facilities, access laneways, stormwater management, and associated components. The Project will connect to the existing 230 kilovolt ("kV") Hydro One Networks Inc. transmission lines located at the southern end of the property.

The Project is required to help address Ontario's growing electricity needs, as identified by Ontario's Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO"). The Project was awarded a long-term capacity contract by the IESO in May 2024. Construction is expected to begin in late 2025, subject to the receipt of all required permits and approvals, with operations commencing in mid-2027.
