### BACKYARD CHICKENS NOW PERMITTED IN SETTLEMENT AREAS

As of April 29, 2025, Township Council has approved Bylaw 2025-22, allowing residents in the Villages of Cardinal, Johnstown, and Spencerville to keep up to five domestic fowl—such as hens or ducks—on their properties. This initiative supports local food production, sustainability, and agricultural education within the community.

Residents interested in keeping domestic fowl must adhere to specific guidelines involving permitted zones, coop and run requirements, setback measurements and containment.
